
#### Teachers & Librarians,

There are so many sources of information in today's world. Newspapers, magazines, television, social media, websites, and more present us with information! When students hear a story about a startling new discovery or a strange creature that is being studied, do they ever wonder if it is *really* true?

The authors of TWO TRUTHS AND A LIE: IT'S ALIVE! (Walden Pond Press) are challenging readers to check the validity of sources in their fun, engaging book. Three non-fiction topics are introduced in each section of the book. Two of those stories are valid scientific topics and one is an invented topic, often the topic of an online hoax. As a school librarian with a passion for STEM topics, I saw this book as an opportunity both to explore interesting stories and to develop crucial information literacy skills.

What's Your Source? provides you with links for students to explore. The resources give students a chance to dig deeper into one of the topics from the book and determine the validity of the sources. Invite students to investigate who wrote each article and why. Give them the chance to compare and cross-check the information before making their final decision on whether the stories in TWO TRUTHS AND A LIE: IT'S ALIVE! are a truth or a lie. You may give each student a different topic to explore and then report back to the class, or you may prefer to have them work in small groups with each member checking on one link and then everyone comparing their results to reach a group verdict about their assigned topic. Either way, they will be looking at the information with a critical eye, which is how you want them to approach any source they use.

#### STEM Investigators.

Are you ready to use your research skills to tell a truth from a lie?

- 1) Read TWO TRUTHS AND A LIE: IT'S ALIVE! by Ammi-Joan Paquette and Laurie Ann Thompson (Walden Pond Press).
- 2) Choose at least 3 of the sources listed in the attached spreadsheets and check them for proof that the story is true or not true. If you have time, find another source and share its URL.

**Before you begin:** Think about what makes information trustworthy. Look carefully at the websites for the story you are verifying. There are several clues to help you determine the purpose of a website, one of which is the ending on the URL. Remember that .gov indicates an official government website, .edu is for an educational group like a school or college, .mil is for the armed services, and .com is for commercial sites, while .org or .net may be used by anyone.

After looking at the URL for clues, look to see who owns the website. Is there an "About Us" link that takes you to information about the owners? What does it say about them? What is their purpose in creating the website? Who provides the information and what qualifies them to be an expert about the subject(s)? When was the website last updated - is the information current or out of date?

Then look at the content of the website. What sort of information is shared? Is the author trying to Persuade, Inform, or Entertain you? The author's purpose will affect what they write. (For instance, the minutes of a city council meeting as reported by their official secretary on the city's municipal website may be presented differently than by the reporter for a special interest group that disagrees with legislation the council was voting on during their last session.) Always look for bias - what is said, how is it said, and what is not said? To be sure that information is accurate, it is always best to confirm the facts with more than one source. Compare what each source says and see if the facts agree.
