

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#### About the Event Kit

This event can be done for one or many preschoolers to playfully celebrate literacy, the natural world, physical activity, and creativity.

The picture book, **Pond Babies** by Cathryn Falwell (Down East Books) is about a child's trip to the pond to observe and match pond animals and their new babies. This event kit allows you to play a pond baby matching game with preschoolers, to replicate the animal movement activities in the back of the book, and to create a simple craft that reminds your preschoolers of the book and event. The kit contains the makings for posters with pockets filled with collectable pond baby cards and instructions for a Pond Babies Bangle craft. The kit also contains an event poster and suggestions on telling families about your event.



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## Preparing for the Event

What You Might Gather to Prepare:
Cardstock
Single-hole paper punch
5 business size envelopes (#10's work well)
Scissors, glue, and tape
What You Might Gather for Day of the Event:
Pipe cleaners (1 for each attendee)
Crayons (enough to share with attendees)
Buttons & beads with holes big enough for a pipe cleaner (5 for each attendee)
Blue sheet or blanket (Optional)
Table for the craft
What You Might Do:

Print the event kit.
Reproduce the Pond Babies Event Poster for advertising the event.
List the event in your advertising using this suggested copy or some of your own devising:
Come to <b>Pond Babies</b> , a picture book event for preschoolers to read, wiggle, color, and create! We will read the picture book <b>Pond Babies</b> by Cathryn Falwell (Down East Books) about a trip to the pond to observe and match pond animals and their new babies. Following the reading we will wiggle like a tadpole, quack like a duck, and go on our own small journey to find babies hidden in our space. Children will collect five pond baby cards and turn them into a fun bangle to take home. All ages, but best for ages 2-5.
See the next page for visual instructions to the following:
Cut the top flaps off of 5 business sized envelopes.
Glue envelopes to bottom of Pond Babies Action Posters under the "and take a pond baby" line.
Fold the excess envelope sides to back of the poster and tape securely. You should now have 5 Ponds
Babies Action Posters with pockets.
Copy one Pond Babies Card set for each anticipated attendee onto white cardstock.
Cut the Pond Babies Cards along the lines.
Hole punch the corners of the Pond Babies Cards where you see the dot.
Sort the Pond Babies Cards into piles by baby.
Stuff the Pond Babies Cards into their corresponding Pond Babies Action Poster.
Put your Pond Babies Cards with the book cover on it with your crayons, pipe cleaners, beads, and
buttons for the day of the event.  Make an example of the Pond Rabies Bangle by threading the Pond Rabies Cards along a nine clear.
Make an example of the Pond Babies Bangle by threading the Pond Babies Cards along a pipe clear interspersed with beads and buttons and then twisting the end of the pipe cleaners.

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## The Day of the Event

#### How You Might Prepare:

\_\_\_\_ Lay out the Pond Babies Card with the book cover on it with your crayons, pipe cleaners, beads, and buttons on a craft table.

\_\_\_\_ Hang the Pond Babies Action Posters stuffed with corresponding Pond Babies Cards around your space. Leave enough room for attendees to do the actions described on the poster. You might also place the posters so preschoolers have to explore your space to find the five posters.


\_\_\_\_ Spread out blue sheets and/or blankets in your reading space to represent a pond. You can invite attendees to sit on the sheets so that they are in and beside the pond just like pond babies.

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### The Day of the Event (cont.)

#### When the Event Starts:

Welcome attendees to your pond to read a story and pretend to be pond babies. \_\_\_\_ Read your copy of **Pond Babies** by Cathryn Falwell and published by Down East Books. \_ Have preschoolers stand up and do the actions with you from the final spread of the book. Tell them to remember how to do these pond baby actions because they will have to do them one more time. Review with preschoolers how many babies there were at the pond. There were five (not counting the child) --a duckling, a loon chick, a fawn, a tadpole, and a turtle. Ask your preschoolers if they would like to take home five pond babies. Encourage them to explore the space with you or their caregivers to find five pond animals. Each poster asks the preschooler to repeat the action and to 'take a card.' Encourage them to do this with you or their caregiver and to then come with their five Pond Babies Cards to the craft table. \_\_\_ At the craft table have the preschoolers write their name on the Pond Babies Card with the book cover on it and color all of their Pond Babies Cards. \_ Have the preschoolers thread the Pond Babies Cards along a pipe clear interspersed with beads and buttons. Help them twist the end of the pipe cleaner to make a Pond Babies Bangle to take home. Congrats! You have run a wonderful event engaging preschoolers with literacy, the natural world, physical activity, and creativity!




