
RED-TAILED HAWK GLIDER He rides the wind like a waye

DIRECTIONS

If it is not attached, you can find the hawk glider template by searching "hawk" at CuriousCityDPW.com.

- 1. Folding to the white side of the template, fold the short side of the paper over to the right, even with the edge, and make a crease.
- 2. Unfold and repeat folding to the left.
- 3. Fold paper as shown to make a point, crease in place.
- 4. Fold each side tip, upward, to make a point.
- 5. Fold top point down now to meet the fold line. Crease well.
- 6. Fold plane in half and crease. Fold each wing back, leaving 1/2 inch at the bottom and crease.
- 7. Fold both outside edges up about 1/4" and leave folded edge pointing upwards.
