Like many new students, Charlie is having trouble finding his place in a new classroom. At first, Charlie's differences feel insurmountable, but finding a shared language with Fiona changes everything. Together they discover their commonalities and come to love their differences.

Whether you are meeting your new class in person or online, Charlie's adventure as a dog in a school of cats can offer some icebreakers.


